## **Edna Mae Nash honored by Parliament**



On December 11, 2012, it was announced in the Parliament of British Columbia that Edna Mae Nash, long time Adlerian would receive the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal posthumously in a ceremony on January 18, 2013.
