Guidelines for Outreach Reports

- 1. Reports should be at least two pages long and <u>sent at the latest by January 1st</u> to Eva Dreikurs Ferguson (efergus@siue.edu) and a copy to Betty Haeussler (bettyicassi@aol.com).
- 2. Reports should be written professionally. The aim of the report is to convey serious outreach efforts in the country or region of the scholarship recipients.
- 3. Reports should begin with a description of the courses and instructors taken during the ICASSI experience, and in these descriptions the reports should identify concrete insights the student learned.
- 4. Reports should next describe the Adler-Dreikurs activity the scholarship recipient made in his country or region, and this description should give concrete details. Activity should describe with whom the work was done and what kind of success the activity achieved.
- 5. Overall, the professional report should give as much concrete detail as possible so that it is clear to what positive use the ICASSI experience contributed in the scholarship recipient's country or region.

The report should be a TYPED WORD DOCUMENT and is due by January 1, 2017
