"Alfred Adler & the Circles of Life" by Hallie Williams and Kristina Pfefer in Faust.

This class is designed to explain Adler's theory of social interest via the Circles of Life. Topics discussed will include Black Lives Matter, Me Too Gangs, Parenting, Marriage and Social Justice. (English)
