- i. You agree to attend all Plenary presentations
- ii. You will read the book by Eva Dreikurs Ferguson, which you can get in English on Amazon and in German from Uti Landscheidt ([u.landscheidt@gmx.de](mailto:u.landscheidt@gmx.de)) ADLERIAN THEORY: An Introduction. Also, you will read other books and articles by Alfred Adler and Rudolf Dreikurs before the start of attending ICASSI.
- iii. You agree that you will initiate and do an activity that provides outreach of Adler-Dreikurs work in your country or region, and that the plans for such activity will be discussed with members of the Scholarship Committee on Monday in the 2<sup>nd</sup> week at ICASSI.
- iv. By **January 1, 2024**, at the latest, you will write a professional report that describes how you implemented your plan.
